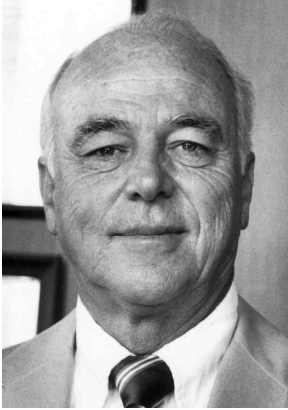

Richard Burress served as assistant to President Gerald Ford from 1973 to 1974 and as deputy counsel to President Richard Nixon from 1969 to 1971. He was also counsel to the House Republican leadership from 1965 to 1969. The holder of a J.D. from the Law School of the University of Iowa, he is the author of *We the People: The Story of Our Constitutional Convention*, *The Bill of Rights: James Madison's Legacy*, and *The Documents of the American Revolution*, which was published in Russian in 1995 and later translated into Romanian. He has also written extensively on Abraham Lincoln and the Civil War. He has been a Hoover fellow since 1973.
