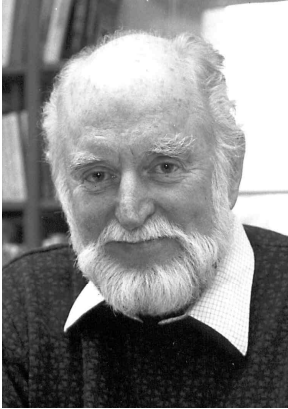


## PETER J. DUIGNAN

A Hoover fellow since 1960, Peter Duignan's current research focuses on development of the Atlantic community since 1958 and immigration to the United States. The author, editor, or coauthor of more than forty books, his most recent is *NATO: Its Present, Past, and Future* (2001). Other recent publications (with the late Lewis Gann) include *The Rebirth of the West: The Americanization of the Democratic World, 1945–1958* (1992) and *Contemporary Europe and the Atlantic Alliance* (1997). The holder of a Ph.D. in history from Stanford University, he is a fellow of the Royal Historical Society in London. He has been a member of the Stanford University African Studies Committee since 1964 and a member of Stanford's European Studies Council since 1985.
