**Expertise: Intellectual and institutional history of China, U.S.-China policy**

The holder of a Ph.D. from Harvard University in history and Far Eastern languages, Thomas Metzger was a professor of history at the University of California, San Diego, before joining the Hoover Institution in 1990. His current research focuses on contemporary China's moral-political discourse and its historical roots, dealing with both China and Taiwan. He also studies Chinese political directions, the culturally distinct modes of political reasoning that influence Chinese policy, and how the United States can best deal with them. In the fall of 2001, he taught a course at Peking University on modern Chinese political thought. His current book project is entitled *A Cloud across the Pacific: Essays on the Clash between Chinese and Western Political Theories Today*.
