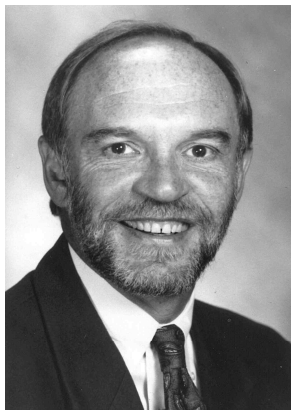

Expertise: Property rights, natural resource and environmental policy



The holder of a Ph.D. in economics from the University of Washington and a Hoover fellow since 1997, Terry Anderson has written a book, with Donald Leal, *Free Market Environmentalism* (1991), that is considered the definitive treatment of the subject and has prompted debate over the proper role of government in managing natural resources. The author or editor of twenty-four other books, including *The Technology of Property Rights* (2001) and *Political Environmentalism: Going behind the Green Curtain* (2000) and coauthor with Laura Huggins of *Property Rights: A Practical Guide to Freedom and Prosperity* (2003), he is currently working on a book on the law and economics of property rights. In addition to his Hoover appointment, he is executive director of the Political Economy Research Center in Bozeman, Montana, and a professor emeritus of economics at Montana State University.
