In addition to his Hoover appointment, Michael Boskin holds an endowed professorship in Stanford University's Department of Economics. He received his Ph.D. from the University of California, Berkeley, and is internationally recognized for his research on world economic growth, tax and budget theory and policy, and U.S. savings and consumption patterns. From 1989 to 1992, he chaired the President's Council of Economic Advisers, and from 1995 to 1996, he chaired the U.S. Congressional Commission on the consumer price index. Currently, he is a member of the panel of advisers to the Congressional Joint Committee on Taxation and the advisory board of the Congressional Budget Office. He is the author or editor of twelve books, including *Frontiers of Tax Reform* (1996). He has been a Hoover fellow since 1993.
