In addition to his Hoover appointment, Gerald Dorfman is a professor of political science, by courtesy, at Stanford University. The holder of a Ph.D. in political science from Columbia University, he served in the Agency for International Development in the U.S. Department of State from 1966 to 1969 and was a professor of political science at Iowa State University from 1971 to 1983. He is coeditor, with Hoover fellow Peter Duignan, of *Politics in Western Europe* (1988 and 1992). He was a cofounder of the British Politics Group and author of three books on the relationship between the British government and the British union movement since 1945. His current research interests focus on British politics as well as Western European political systems and the European Union.
