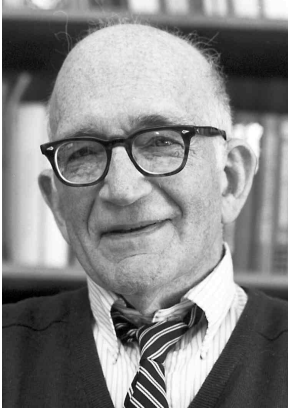


SIDNEY D. DRELL

In addition to his Hoover appointment, Sidney Drell is a professor emeritus of theoretical physics at the Stanford Linear Accelerator Center, where he served as deputy director before retiring in 1998. The holder of a Ph.D. in physics from the University of Illinois, he has been active since 1960 as an adviser to the executive and legislative branches of the U.S. government on national security and defense technical issues. He is the author of many books, including *Facing the Threat of Nuclear Weapons* (1983 and 1989) and *In the Shadow of the Bomb: Physics and Arms Control* (1993). He is a fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, the National Academy of Sciences, and the American Philosophical Society.
