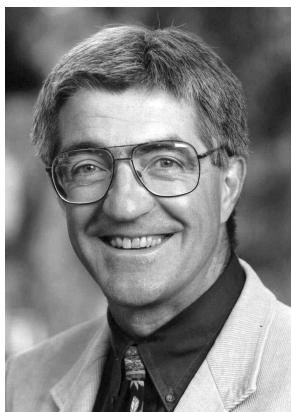


MORRIS P. FIORINA

Appointed a Hoover fellow in 1998, Morris Fiorina also holds an endowed professorship in Stanford University's Department of Political Science. A University of Rochester Ph.D., he was a professor of government at Harvard University before coming to Hoover. His current research addresses the increased polarization of American politics and electoral change over the past half-century. The author of six books, his most recent is *The New American Democracy* (1998), with Hoover fellow Paul Peterson. A member of the National Academy of Sciences and the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, Fiorina currently serves on the editorial boards of six journals, including *Congress and the Presidency*, *Public Choice*, and the *Journal of Law, Economics, and Organization*.
