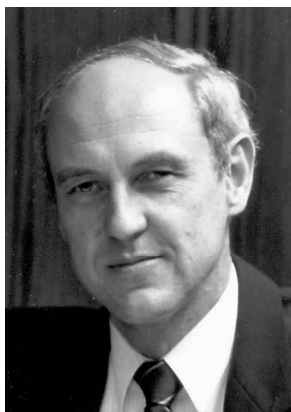


CHARLES E. McLURE JR.

A former deputy assistant secretary of the treasury for tax analysis, Charles McLure has also served as a senior economist on the staff of the President's Council of Economic Advisers. A Hoover fellow since 1981, he has written extensively on federal tax reform, intergovernmental fiscal relations, the value-added tax and other forms of consumption-based taxation, and corporate taxation. His current research focuses on taxation of electronic commerce. The holder of a Ph.D. in economics from Princeton, books he has written or edited include *The Value-Added Tax: Key to Deficit Reduction* (1987) and, with Hoover fellow Michael Boskin, *World Tax Reform* (1990).
