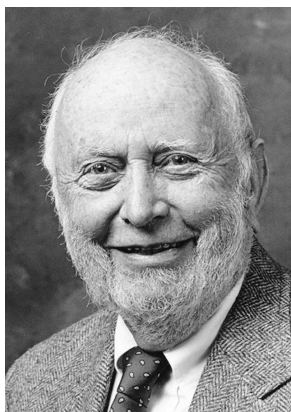


## DOUGLASS C. NORTH

**Expertise: Property rights, economic organization in history, ideology and the growth of government, theory of institutional change**



Winner of the Nobel Memorial Prize in economic sciences in 1993, Douglass North has been a Hoover fellow since 1997. In addition, he holds an endowed professorship in the Department of Economics at Washington University, where he was director of the Center in Political Economy from 1984 to 1990. The author or editor of nine books, many of which have appeared in numerous editions and have been translated into foreign languages, his forthcoming book is an analysis of the process of economic change. In addition, he is collaborating with Hoover fellow Barry Weingast on a book on order, disorder, and economic change. The holder of a Ph.D. in economics from the University of California, Berkeley, he is a fellow of the British Academy and a member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.
