William Perry served as U.S. secretary of defense from 1994 to 1997. He previously served as deputy secretary of defense, 1993 to 1994, and as undersecretary of defense for research and engineering, 1977 to 1981. In addition to his Hoover appointment, he holds an endowed professorship at Stanford University, with a joint appointment in the School of Engineering and the Institute for International Studies. In 1998, he was named North Korea policy coordinator for the United States. His most recent book, with Ashton B. Carter, is *Preventive Defense: A New Security Strategy for America* (1999). The holder of a Ph.D. in mathematics from the University of Pennsylvania, he has received many awards, including the Presidential Medal of Freedom. He is a member of the National Academy of Engineering and the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.
