Additionally, she is a research professor at New York University. A former professor of history and education at Columbia University Teachers College, she has written numerous books on American education policy, including *Left Back: A Century of Battles over School Reform* (2000), *The Schools We Deserve* (1987), and *The Troubled Crusade: American Education, 1945–1980* (1985). She is a member of the National Academy of Education, the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, the National Assessment Governing Board, and the Society of American Historians.
